

TRANSFER TO RAFFLES MILANO ADMISSION PROCEDURE TO THE SECOND YEAR

Raffles Milano welcomes transfer students from other universities, design institutes and from Raffles Colleges worldwide through a dedicated admission process.

Here's how it works:

1) Initial Contact and Info Session	Prospective transfer students should begin by booking an online or in- person info session with the admissions team. This session helps clarify the course structure, expectations, and the transfer process.
2) Document Submission	 Applicants must submit the following documents: Identification documents. Personal statement or motivation letter. Academic transcripts and course syllabi from the current or previous institution.
	 Portfolio (strongly suggested). High School Diploma These materials are used to assess the compatibility of previously earned credits with Raffles Milano's curriculum.



3) Credit Comparison and Recognition	The academic team at Raffles Milano will conduct a credit evaluation to
	determine which previously completed courses can be recognized. This
	step ensures that the student can enter directly into the second year
	without academic gaps.
	Moreover, the entry requirements to the Italian Education System will be
	evaluated according to the High School Diploma submitted.
	This process may take some time therefore students are required to start
	it within the following timeframes:
	 Non European students: start the Transfer procedure between
	March and May and complete it within the end of June for admission
	to the following fall intake.
	 Italian and European students: start the Transfer procedure
	between March and June and complete it within the end of July for
	admission to the following fall intake.
	In case the full transcripts are not available when the application is
	started, they must be submitted as soon as available. The evaluation will
	be performed upon the syllabi and final acceptance into the course will be
	confirmed only after the documents are submitted.
4) Interview with Program Leader or	A motivational interview is scheduled with the program leader or
	Academic Director. This is not a technical or design test but rather an
	evaluation of the student's passion, goals, and fit for the program. The
Academic Director	credit recovery plan, if available, will be explained as well as the exam
	procedures.
	Once the interview and eredit recognition are complete, successful
5) Admission Decision and Enrollment	Once the interview and credit recognition are complete, successful candidates receive an admission offer. Enrollment is finalized upon
	payment of fees and submission of any remaining documents.
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TOP UP procedure (2+2) for Raffles College Students

Students from other Raffles Colleges benefit from a flexible and simplified inter-school transfer scheme, allowing them to move between campuses within the Raffles Education Network. This system supports cultural exchange and academic continuity.

Specifically, students who complete an Advanced Diploma (minimum 6 + 18 months) in the following subjects will be able to gain simplified admission to the second year of the correspondent BA in Raffles Milano and obtain an Academic Diploma I Level*, after successfully completing the 2nd and 3rd year.

The curricula of the above-mentioned programs have been previously assessed (see point 3. of the Transfer Procedure) and therefore any student holding such a qualification will benefit from a simplified and quicker admission process and a privileged tuition fee discounted by 30%.

Such students will be admitted to the second year of the relevant course and will have to recover a few credits through self-study and sustain an exam during the first available session.

They will also have to choose between the available specialisation paths of the relevant course, and, in particular:

Admission to the second semester of the second year (March) will be evaluated on a case-to-case basis.

Students from other Raffles Colleges who hold Advanced Diplomas in the following subjects: Animation Design, Digital Media Design, Jewellery Design, Photography, Fashion Marketing and Management will be able to submit their personal transcript for standard credits evaluation. The number of credits to recover will be evaluated on a case-to-case basis. They will still benefit from a privileged tuition fee discounted by 30%.

*Students must be in possession of the prerequites to access the Italian education system (12 years of schooling and access to the University in the same system where the high school diploma was issued, eg: GaoKao and Yikao exam in China).
